The Sixth Form opened in September 2012, providing a wide range of both A Level and A Level equivalent qualifications.

It's an exciting time to join the SJBC Sixth Form as it is a growing sixth form based around the needs of all our students. SJBC is developing into a thriving community of dynamic, happy and highly successful students. We ensure a supportive and caring environment in which every student matters. FACILITIES

The building of the school was completed in 2015 and therefore boasts some superb 'state of the art' facilities. The Sixth Form has a new independent study area which has access to computers and literature. There are also a number of study areas available at all times, furthermore the students have access to further IT and our magnificent Apple MAC computer room.

The Sixth Form area is managed by the students through the Sixth Form Committee and staff. The Learning Resources Centre (LRC) is another area available for quiet study and is also equipped with IT. The Sixth Form students also have a separate modern dining area and hopefully a new all day coffee area.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME

Enrichment and extra-curricular activities are very important at SJBC. We believe that every student should have the opportunity to participate in something non-curricular based to broaden their horizons. Apart from university visits, our work experience programme, Wandsworth Enterprise week, and the various subject specific trips that are on offer; we also run a compulsory enrichment programme where students have to sign up and complete some of the following courses/awards which are timetabled every week, these include: Sound Engineering, Up-cycling, Music Production, Drama, Sports/Circuits/Gym, Police Cadets and London Life Savers.
