Dear Parents of children in year 11,

We are looking forward to welcoming children in Year 11 back to school tomorrow, **Tuesday 8 September**. They will start with an introductory assembly at **8.40am**. Please note that they should not arrive earlier than 8.30am. They will leave school at **1.40pm** every day this week and from next week they will finish at 2.30pm except on Fridays when they will finish at 1.20pm. Once dismissed your child should go straight home from school and not wait outside school or in the local area in groups.

To ensure that we reduce contact between children in different year group ‘bubbles’ where possible we have temporarily altered the timings of the school day to create staggered start and finish times for the different year groups. These timings, along with all safety measures are under regular review and we will alert you of any changes
