Dear Parents of children in year 9

I am writing to remind that children in Year 8 are due to return to school tomorrow, Wednesday 9 September, with an introductory assembly at **9.50am**. They will leave school at **11.10am**. They will then work at home with online lessons following their normal school timetable for the remainder of this week and next Monday, then start attending school each day from Tuesday 15 September. As I have explained in previous letters we want to ensure that each year group is given a phased reintroduction to school to ensure that they fully understand and can settle in to the changes to routines forced upon us by the pandemic.

To ensure that we reduce contact between children in different year group ‘bubbles’ where possible we have temporarily altered the timings of the school day to create staggered start and finish times for the different year groups. For the time being your child’s school start and finish times will be as set out below. It is important that they arrive promptly for these times and do not come to school earlier or later than required. These timings, along with all safety measures are under regular review and we will alert you of any changes.
