Dear Parents/Carers

You will no doubt have heard in the news that concern over a new variant of Coronavirus has led to the Government reintroducing some safety measures into schools to help prevent the spread of the virus.

From tomorrow, Tuesday 30 November 2021, government guidance is that all students (unless medically exempt) will be expected to wear a face covering in communal areas of the school such as the corridors and canteen area. I would be grateful if you could ensure that your child brings a suitable face covering (plain, without logo) to school each day.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you to keep testing your child regularly (twice a week) even if they are asymptomatic. Test kits are available from reception. If your child does develop any Covid type symptoms, please do not send them in to school until and unless they have tested negative for the virus.

It is important that we keep one another safe and I would ask you to stress the importance of maintaining adequate social distancing and practising good hand hygiene, to your child, so that they can play their part in reducing risk of transmission at school.
