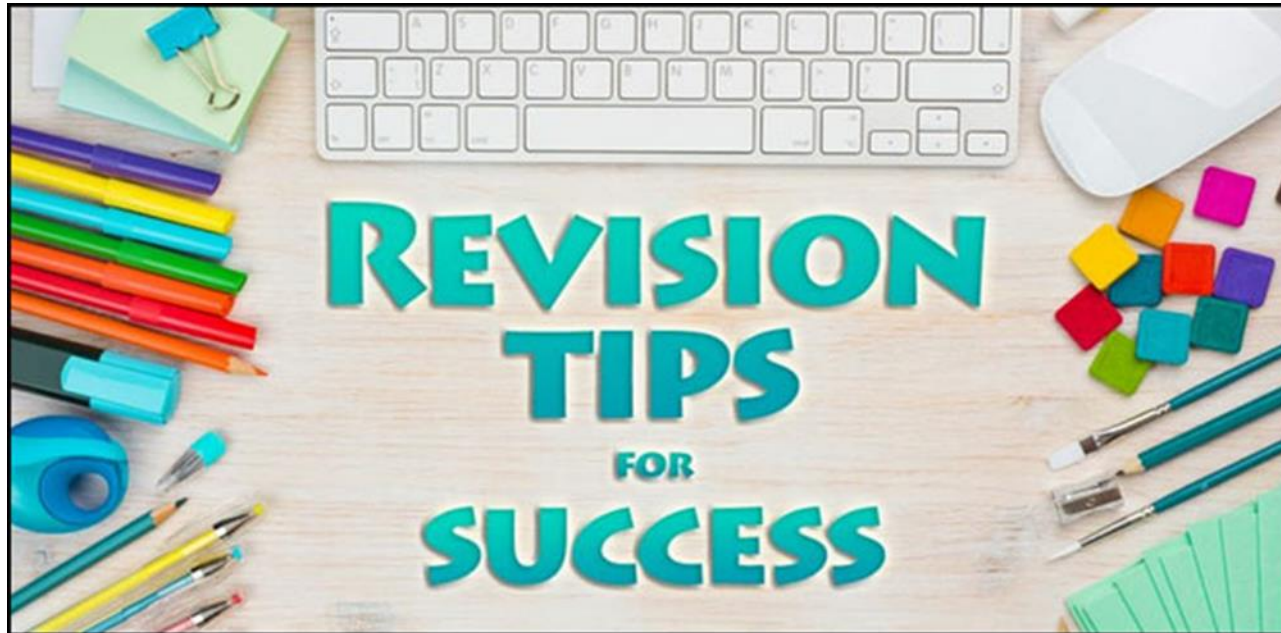

Cognition and Behaviour 1hr 45mins</p> <p>Paper 2 Social Context and Behaviour 1hr 45mins (Research Methods is in both papers)</p>	https://www.aqa.org.uk/subjects/psychology/gcse/psychology-8182/assessment-resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice 9-mark questions using the essay structures you have been given • For key studies make sure you know the key areas – aim, procedure (method), findings, conclusion and evaluations of it • Refer back to the specification for which specific studies you <u>must</u> know (questions can get specifically asked on these studies!) • When doing past paper questions, read the command word really carefully – if it just says evaluate, don't waste time describing, if it says outline and evaluate then you need to do AO1 and AO3, if it just says describe/outline/explain then it's AO1 only...
