Re: Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) June/July 2026

As we are coming to the end of the academic year 2025-2026, I would like to thank you all for your work in supporting the school and our children in making a memorable year here at St John Bosco College. Throughout the academic year, Year 8 students have impressed staff with the high-quality work they are producing and their active engagement in lessons.

Our second set of Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) will be from Monday 29 June 2026 until Friday 3 July 2026. The PPEs are a fantastic opportunity for the students to demonstrate what they have learnt this year and for teachers to measure their progress and attainment. They also allow students to gain valuable experience of taking exams under timed conditions.

Year 8 PPE Timetable

- All students in Year 8 will follow their normal timetable each day for Periods 1 and 2 except on Friday 3 July where they will sit a reading age assessment.
- All students in need to arrive each day by 8:35am and line up with the whole school.
- Breaktime will be from 10:30 – 10:45am
- After the whole school line up at 10:45, students will line up in the playground ready to enter the Sports Hall for their exams.
- All students will sit two exams each day during Period 3 and 4.
- Lunchtime will be from 13:00 – 13:50
- All students will be dismissed at 14:00 after a key stage 3 line up.

Please note that if your child has PE timetabled Period 1 and 2 on Tuesday 30 June, they will be taking part in practical PE and therefore should bring in their full school uniform to change into after PE as normal.

Exam results for all year groups will be shared with parents through the Arbor app. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's tutor if you have any questions about this process.
