Year 9 PPE Timetable

- All students in Year 9 will follow the assessment timetable below and attend their timetabled lessons when not in an assessment.
- All students will sit a Reading Age Assessment on Thursday 2 July.
- All students in need to arrive each day by 8:35am and line up with the whole school.
- Breaktime will be from 10:30 – 10:45am
- After the whole school line up at 10:45, students will line up in the playground ready to enter the Sports Hall for their exams.
- All students will sit two exams each day during Period 3 and 4.
- Lunchtime will be from 13:00 – 13:50
- All students will be dismissed at 14:00 after a key stage 3 line up.

Please note that if your child has PE timetabled Period 1 and 2 on Friday 3 July, they will not be taking part in practical PE and therefore should attend school in their full school uniform.
