**Re: Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) June/July 2026**

As we are coming to the end of the academic year 2025-2026, I would like to thank you all for your work in supporting the school and our children in making a memorable year here at St John Bosco College. Throughout the academic year, Year 10 students have impressed staff with the high-quality work they are producing in this first year of GCSE's and their active engagement in lessons.

Our second set of Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs) will be from Friday 19 June 2026 until Friday 26 June 2026. The PPEs are a fantastic opportunity for the students to demonstrate what they have learnt this year and for teachers to measure their progress and attainment. They also allow students to gain valuable experience of taking exams under timed conditions.

During this PPE week the school's regular timetable is replaced by a key stage specific timetable tailored to the number of exams being taken and the examination spaces in the school.

## Year 10 PPE Timetable

- All students in Year 10 will follow the assessment timetable below.
- All students need to arrive each day by 8:35am and line up with the whole school.
- They will sit one exam every morning at 9:00am.
- Breaktime will be from 10:30 – 10:45am followed by the whole school line up and tutor time.
- Students will then have their Period 3 lessons with their regular teachers or a Portuguese, French or Spanish listening/speaking exam, should they study those subjects.
- All students in Year 10 will have a reading age assessment on Monday 29 June. GCSE PE students will not have a practical lesson that morning and should therefore arrive in school wearing their full school uniform.
- Lunch will be Period 4.
- All students will line up at 12:40pm in the playground ready to sit their afternoon exam at 13:00.
- Students will be dismissed each day after the completion of their second exam. This time is likely to be between 14:00 – 16:00 depending on the length of the exam taken.

Exam results for all year groups will be shared with parents through the Arbor app. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's tutor if you have any questions about this process.
